# HOLY COMMUNION

This is my blood and with it God makes new His agreement with you. It is shed for you, and for everyone, for the forgiveness of sins. Drink this and remember me.

Soon we will eat this bread: **We will remember Jesus.** 

Soon we will drink this wine: **We will remember Jesus.** 

These are the gifts of God for the people of God:

We will remember Jesus.

Jesus says: I am the bread of life, whoever eats this bread will live forever.

Lord, our hearts hunger for you; give us this bread always.

Alleluia!

Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us. Therefore, let us keep the feast. Alleluia!

#### RENEWAL OF BAPTISM VOWS
